Dear Friends,

The Church Council for Oadby Trinity met on Monday of this week. The decisions made are specific to just that one church, but I think that they are relevant to my readers at Glen, Houghton and Aigburth so I'm including you all in this newsletter circulation.

Covid restrictions

The tone of the debate was cautious. Our commitment to Test & Trace, maximising ventilation, encouraging mask wearing, and social distancing remains in place. We have agreed that singing is acceptable provided a mask is being worn. The Minister and Stewards were given discretion for subsequent relaxation, but we expect to move slowly. We hope that will give people confidence to return to worshipping in-person.

We aren't serving coffee yet, but people will be encouraged to stay and chat if they wish and may bring their own flask of coffee or other drinks.

Online Communion

There were some really thoughtful and helpful contributions to a long conversation. We remain committed to making Communion available in several different ways: there will be services at Aigburth, Home Communion available and Extended Communion taken to people who cannot attend.

We agreed that we should only introduce online Communion if there was a 2/3 majority in favour and we narrowly failed to achieve that, so we will not be implementing online Communion yet.

Same Sex Marriage

We had a very respectful conversation about Same Sex Marriage. Questions were taken to ensure that the Methodist Conference decisions were understood. We noted that we'd not had any enquiries about booking such a ceremony but that any decision would make a public statement about our commitment to Inclusion.

We agreed that we would not proceed without a 2/3 majority. The vote was overwhelmingly in favour so we will move toward registering Oadby Trinity Methodist Church as a venue for Same Sex Marriage as soon as the legislation permits.
